## Authentication

### How Do We Know It's You?

Security begins with authenticating that it is really you requesting the information and not someone who has stolen your identity. Our goal is to ensure that the level of authentication called for in a particular transaction is appropriate to the transaction level of risk.

## How can you stay safe?

*The best way to protect yourself from cybercrime is to use common sense, be prepared and take precautions.*

### Online Transactions

- Shop with trusted merchants.
- Only shop on secure websites.
- Print or save records of your online transactions.
- Review the privacy policy for the website or merchant. How are they handling your information?

### Passwords

- Do not set your computer to save passwords.
- Change passwords frequently.
- Use strong passwords.
- Do not use numbers associated with your birthday, anniversary, Social Security number, phone number, etc.
- Do not use names of family members.
- Use separate passwords for work and non-work related accounts.

### Computer

- Use firewall protection.
- Use and update anti-virus software regularly.
- Use anti-malware programs.
- Use operating system patches and updates.
- Secure wireless networks.

### Internet

- Never provide personal information on an unsecured website.
- Do not respond to unsolicited email (spam) or provide personal information.
- Do not open attachments contained in a suspicious email.
- Do not enter personal information in a pop-up screen.
- Monitor accounts to make sure there is no unauthorized access.
