Activity Level - 2 Moderate

You like a balanced approach to travel. Walking two to three miles over the course of a day is no problem for you. You can partake in a two-hour leisurely walking tour, covering up to two miles (with included breaks). You can handle a variety of terrains, from cobblestone streets to moderate hills with relative ease and without assistance. You can climb two flights of stairs with ease. There may be 1 to 2 days on this tour when walking tours can cover 3 to 4 miles over uneven terrain. You can handle altitudes up to 6,000 feet.

CANADIAN ROCKIES TOUR ITINERARY

Day 1 - Saturday, June 13th

Vancouver, British Columbia - Set out to explore the beautiful Canadian Rockies by train. Arrive today in the city of Vancouver. With arrival times varying, there are no scheduled activities today.

Day 2 - Sunday, June 14th

Meals included: Breakfast and Dinner

Vancouver, British Columbia - This morning, ascend the Grouse Mountain on an enclosed gondola and with views in every direction while you enjoy breakfast on the peak of Vancouver. Then, join a ranger to meet two grizzly bears that were rescued in 2001. Later, begin your Vancouver sightseeing tour at beautiful Stanley Park, Canada's renowned urban rainforest. Follow the park's famous seawall and discover views of the mountains along trails, beaches, historical landmarks, and colorful gardens. Make your way to picturesque Granville Island Public Market to stroll through its fascinating stalls of handmade crafts and artisan food producers. This evening, enjoy dinner with your fellow travelers at a local restaurant.

Vancouver - Rocky Mountaineer - Kamloops - Onboard Rocky Mountaineer, embark on an awe-inspiring rail journey as you travel through some of the world's most majestic scenery. Beyond your sparkling glass window, enjoy views of coastal deep-green forests, roaring river canyons, and snowcapped mountain peaks. From Vancouver, B.C. to Banff, Alberta, let the Rocky Mountaineer bring you on a spectacular voyage through the verdant farmlands of the Fraser Valley and the towering peaks of the Coast Mountains. Inside your single-level dome coach, gaze out at the stunning panoramas of the mighty Fraser River and the raging white waters of Hell's Gate. Watch the landscape transform again, this time to a semi-arid desert, as you travel toward the city of Kamloops for your overnight stay in a hotel.

Day 4 - Tuesday, June 16th

Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner

Kamloops - Rocky Mountaineer - Lake Louise, Alberta - Continue east this morning to the spectacular Canadian Rocky Mountains. History comes alive as you travel this legendary rail route that united Canada as a nation, through the century-old Spiral Tunnels and along the powerful Kicking Horse River. Traverse the Continental Divide and keep an eye out for moose, elk, and bighorn sheep — not to mention osprey, soaring eagles, even the occasional bear. After another beautiful day onboard Rocky Mountaineer, raise a glass for a final toast. Arrive this evening in the picturesque village of Lake Louise and settle into the famous Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise, a stunning property nestled along the banks of the lake. This evening, dine at one of the great restaurants at Fairmont Chateau.

Day 5 - Wednesday, June 17th


Meals included: Breakfast

Lake Louise - Banff - Enjoy a leisurely morning and admire the enchanting turquoise waters of the lake. Set off for a scenic drive through Banff featuring the powerful Bow Falls and Surprise Corner, known for its picture-perfect panoramic views. Next, meet a local ammolite specialist to learn about this rare gemstone found only in Alberta. During an afternoon at leisure, perhaps you will take a stroll through Banff's charming downtown.


















Day 6 - Thursday, June 18th

Meals included: Breakfast and Dinner

Banff - Icefields Parkway - Banff - A wonderful day of sightseeing awaits as you set out along the unforgettable Icefields Parkway. Marvel at impressive waterfalls, rushing rivers, glacial peaks, imposing cliffs, and the picture-perfect snowcapped mountain ranges. Stop at the Athabasca Glacier where it's your choice! Take a fun ride across this 1,000-foot-thick mass of glacial ice – the largest accumulation of ice south of the Arctic Circle, or take a walk on the Columbia Icefield Skywalk to experience the breathtaking views of the Sunwapta Valley and witness the dramatic landscape from the glass-floored platform. This afternoon, stop at Bow Lake – a beautiful crystal-clear lake fed by Bow Glacier – for photographs and a walk along its shore. We'll also make a stop at Peyto Lake on our return to Banff.

Day 7 - Friday, June 19th

Meals included: Breakfast and Dinner

Banff - Calgary - Enjoy a morning at leisure in Banff before heading to Calgary, where the wild West meets industrial skyscrapers. Stop at Cave and Basin National Historic Site, whose protected land led to the birth of Canada's first national park. Tonight, join in a farewell dinner celebrating the end of a memorable trip.

Day 8 - Saturday, June 20th

Meals included: Breakfast

Calgary - Tour Ends - Your adventure comes to a close today, leaving you with many memories of your extraordinary journey through the awe-inspiring Canadian Rockies.

Travel Savvy Tips

Here is a list of entities we recommend you contact before you depart on your tour:

- 1. Your cell phone/mobile carrier if you are planning on using your device. You will want to confirm you will have access in the area(s) you will visit and inquire about any charges you may incur.
- 2. Your credit card company for any card(s) you plan to use. Make sure the card company knows when and where you will be traveling to avoid any charges being declined.
- 3. Your bank, so you can use your ATM/debit card worry-free. If you are travelling to another country, your bank will be able to tell you if your card will work at the ATM machines to dispense local currency, including if your PIN will be accepted. Also, indicate if you plan to use your debit card as a credit card if your card has that option. Your bank will advise you of any charges for each transaction as well.

Leave a copy of your itinerary, hotel list (included in your tour documents bundle) and a contact number with a designated person in case an emergency comes up while you're away and someone needs to reach you.

We recommend you leave a copy of your passport at home in a secure location and bring an additional copy with you as a precaution.

During your flight, make sure to stand up and walk around as much as possible, and drink plenty of water. These simple suggestions will help you stay comfortable, particularly during long flights.

Travel Protection Plan(TPP) - \$599 per person

The travel protection program provides comprehensive coverage to safeguard your travel investment- from trip cancellation and interruption, to medical emergencies and baggage protection. For a small additional cost, you can have the invaluable peace of mind knowing you're covered if the unexpected occurs during your travels.

Important Travel Information

A deposit of \$698 per person is due upon reservation. Reservations are made on first come, first served basis.Reservations made after the deposit due date of November 23, 2025 are based upon availability. Final payment due by March 15, 2026. Deposits are refundable up until November 30, 2025. In order to avoid any unnecessary change fees, it is imperative that all guest names are entered correctly from the start. The information must be the legal name and be 100% identical to the ID being used to travel (passport/driver's license) including middle name or suffixes (Jr., Sr.).

Some countries require that your passport be valid at least six months beyond the dates of your trip. Some airlines will not allow you to board if this requirement is not met.

Children over the age of 5 may travel as long as they are accompanied by an adult. Child land rates are valid for ages 5-12, sharing a room with two full-paying adults.
